

***MV Christmas Bird Count Feeder Count Data Instructions  
December 31st, 2023 (Sunday)***



**How to Conduct a Feeder Count**

- RECORD THE TIME WHEN YOU FIRST BEGIN WATCHING YOUR FEEDER
- Watch your feeder as much as possible on the Count Day.
- Each time you watch, record how many of each species you observe.
- Report the largest number of individuals of any one species that are observed at the same time. Example: Feeder watched five times between 9 and 10am, where 5, 7, 2, 4 and 1 chickadees were observed. Report 7 chickadees (NOT 19).
- RECORD THE TIME WHEN YOU STOP WATCHING YOUR FEEDER FOR THE DAY
